



What is Erasmus+?

- EU programme to support education, training, youth and sport
- Funding for programmes, projects and scholarships
- Fosters EU-EU and EU-international cooperation
- Erasmus+ programme started in 2015 and is now in its new generation 2021-2027
- Lebanon is eligible to participate in many of its actions

International dimension of Erasmus+ 2021-2027






International Credit mobility

International Credit Mobility (ICM)

1 Higher Education Institution from a Programme Country (ex :
FR, DE, SP, TR,...)

AND

1 Higher Education Institution from a Partner Country (ex: Lebanon)

Make an agreement to host and send students



How does it work?

Under this agreement, it can host students, doctoral candidates or staff from the Partner-Country HEI, and can also send students or doctoral candidates to the Partner-Country HEI.

In the agreement, the sending and receiving/host institutions agree on the range of courses open to visiting students.

These agreements make sure that the sending institution will recognise the credits gained by its students for successfully completed activities abroad, which will contribute to the student's degree once they return.



ICM in brief

Short-term higher education mobility

For students: 3-12 months in each duty cycle

All levels: BA, MA, PhD

Generous grant... and no tuition fees!



Individual support

EUR 700-900/month for students and
EUR 140-180/day for staff

EUR 79/day up to the 14th day of activity and
EUR 56/day from 15th to the 30th day of
activity in case of blended mobility



Contribution to travel costs

EUR 20-1500, depending on distance
travelled



How can a Lebanese student apply?

- The student should already be enrolled in a recognised Lebanese higher education institution.
- The student should contact the **International Relations Office (IRO)** at his/her institution to see what International Credit Mobility projects with Programme country institutions are offering scholarships and how to apply.
- Issues to discuss with IRO: conditions of submission and selection, identifying courses to be studied in host institution, signing learning agreement, checking with your HEI about accommodation and opening bank account at host country, agreeing with host institution about buying tickets on students' behalf, recognising the credits taken at host institution, writing mission report when the student is back ...

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees



Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

- ✓ Highly integrated Master study programmes delivered by international HEI consortium from Programme Countries & Partner Countries
- ✓ No restriction in disciplines
- ✓ Full scholarships for best students from all over the world
- ✓ Fully recognised and award of a joint or multiple Master degree
- ✓ Duration 12 - 18 - 24 months (60 – 90 – 120 ECTS credits)
- ✓ Mandatory study period in at least 2 different Programme Countries

- Open to bachelor students worldwide
- The best ones can benefit from a scholarship
- Attention to students with special needs
- Students apply directly to the EMJM consortium

EMJMD Catalogue

Provide keywords and filter by field of study e.g. gender studies, physical education etc.

Student scholarship

Full Scholarship to cover subsistence, installation and travel + fee waiver

A single unit cost per scholarship holder

How to calculate: € 1400 x number of months
(min. 1 academic year - max. 24 months)

=> max. amount of scholarship per student: 33 600 Euros

How can a Lebanese Student apply?

❖ Students apply directly to the EMJMD consortium.

❖ EMJMD scholarship holders:

- must have a **first higher education degree** or equivalent
- must **not have received** an Erasmus Mundus Master Course and/or Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorate scholarship/fellowship in the past
- can submit a scholarship **application to maximum three** EMJMD programmes
- must sign a **student agreement** with the EMJMD consortium

European Solidarity Corps




Are you between 18 and 30 and looking for a volunteering opportunity to help the wider community, in Europe and beyond?
